Tobermory 21yr Marsala finish is by far one of the interesting and spectacular whiskies to come through our doors in the past year

We then journey onwards to the cradle of Japanese whisky. The place where it all began back in 1923, the **Yamazaki** distillery, as we sample this incredible and very sought after 12yr.

We then finish our journey by checking in with the younger generation of inventive distillers, with a modern and exceptionally smooth grain whisky from the **Chita** distillery **Price 250 dkk**

Now to the Far East and the much fabled **Nikka Taketsuru 21y**r a splendid example of Japanese whisky at its finest.

Our final destination is on the Isle of Islay just off the west coast of Scotland. Lagavulin hardly needs any introduction but the ultra rare 26yr release will certainly leave an impression.
